Anyone who lives in the parish, or has lived in the parish at some time in the last five years, or is on our electoral register, or has a reserved grave, can be interred.

Grave plots can no longer be reserved.

The rules apply to both burials and cremations.

Gravestones and inscriptions need official approval before being placed.

Parish residents, their children and grandchildren can be married or baptised here.

There are many ways to support your church and keep it serving our community, including financial giving, helping with ground or buildings maintenance, lawn mowing, flower arranging, cleaning or being on the PCC.

Garden Waste Subscription Service

If you would like to subscribe to the Warwick District Council (WDC) garden waste service for the period 1st April 2025 to 31st March 2026 (with a two-week break over the Christmas and New year period) there is a charge of £47 per bin for the service.

Once subscribed, you can use your existing green bin by placing the permit on the bin. Be aware that from 1st April 2025, only green bins that are displaying a valid permit will be emptied.

Dear Residents,

Parish Precept

The Parish Council have considered your precept, which is the portion of your Council Tax used to maintain our Village and the wider Parish.

At this time of increased living costs, we have been very strict with the budget, keeping the increase to £2.86 for the next tax year, which is less than 1p more per day for a typical Band D household.

In total, we are due to receive £19438 of WDC precept from about 360 homes within the Parish.

Our biggest single expense is connected to open space maintenance through grass mowing, hedge cutting, insurance, planting and tree work.

We also organise safety inspections and repair of the playground, we liaise with County and District Councils to get street lights repaired, potholes filled, rubbish removed, verges maintained, streets cleaned, grit

bins refilled, dog bins emptied, open spaces secured and much, much more.

Statutory expenses such as financial audits, legal costs, employment of a Clerk, insurance and payments to Government bodies such as the Information Commissioner's Office are also covered by the Precept.

I wish to stress that your precept does not contribute to Councillor salaries or expenses. They are unpaid volunteers.

The precept also does not pay for organised events. These are paid for by groups such as Baginton Events, who are financially independent of the Parish Council.

Annual Assembly

This year, the Annual Parish Assembly will be held on Thursday 10th April from 7:30pm in the Village Hall main room. Everybody is welcome. Short reports will be received from Charities and organisations that work within our village and questions will be taken from the public. Police, County Councillors and District Councillors will all be invited to answer any questions you may have.

Potholes and Road Surfaces

Potholes and deteriorating roads and pavement are often evident at this time of year. Warwickshire County Council has produced a pamphlet of useful information, which has been put on the home page of our village website.

It also explains how to setup your phone to report potholes simply and quickly.

If you use the application a lot, you can make things easier by creating an account and let your phone know your exact location on the interactive map. Alternatively, you can simply report as a guest. You can check if a pothole has already been reported, when it is due to be addressed and receive e-mail updates if you want. The plan is to make reporting potholes easy. Take a look at warwickshire.gov.uk/potholes


